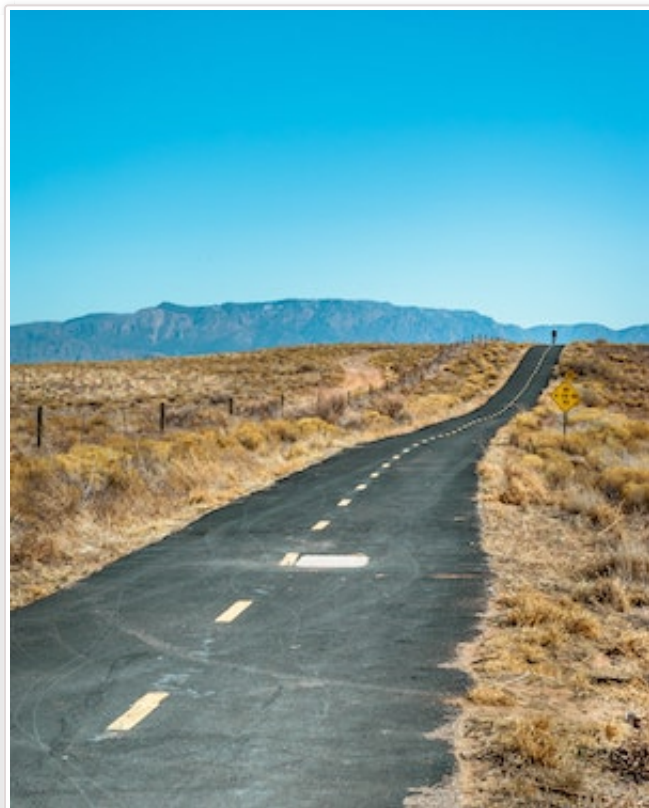
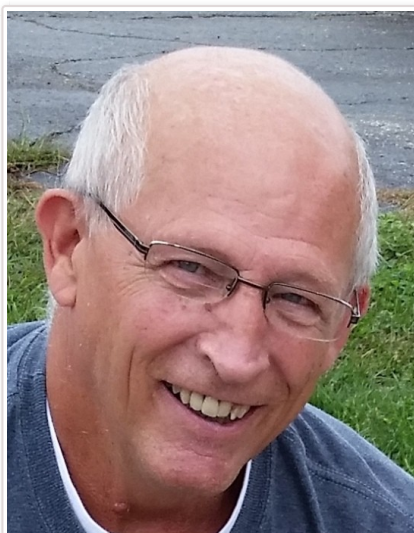


Ronald P. SIMONIS
