Year in Review

While the society did not have any programs scheduled for this year, we have been quite busy.

Our first project for 1994 was the Third Annual History Writing Contest for the Eagle Elementary School fourth graders. The entries were few as Mrs. Gnatzig gave the students the choice to participate or not. Danny Walsh won first prize with his report "Alice Baker"; Kevin Sorensen, second, with "Paradise Springs" and Melissa Sampson, third, with "Eagle's Oldest House". The E. H. S. panel at E. E. Second, was our float for the Kettle Moraine Days' Parade in June. It depicted the 1921 dedication of the bandstand that used to be in what is now Gerald von Rueden Park. THANKS many times over, go to Ed Mueller for constructing the replica of the bandstand, for the use of his wagon and for driving the tractor in the parade. Member Irma Jolliffe along with our contest winners rode on the float for which we received a second place plaque in the Civic category.

In August, Danny, Kevin and Melissa gave their reports before our meeting and Pat Wilton presented them with their checks and other prizes.

On September 9th and 10th, the society undertook a new fundraiser--- a White Elephant/Bake Sale. Due to all of you that donated items, money and time, it was a great success and \$730.31 was raised. Also we are grateful to the many non-members that so generously donated items.


