Schearer Dies; Was Official in Eagle Village

EAGLE — Clare Schearer, a lifelong resident of Eagle and longtime elected official in the village died Thursday at the Muskego Nursing home after a brief illness. He was 89.

Schearer farmed in the town of Eagle until 1914 and then served as the Eagle postmaster until 1919. Schearer also operated a grocery store in the village until 1923. He worked for the county highway department from 1923 until his retirement about 20 years ago.

Schearer served as village president from 1936 to 1939. He was village clerk for 12 years and also served on the village board.

Schearer is survived by sons Robert of Hulbert, Okla.; Waldo of Eagle and Howard of Watertown.

Funeral services will be Monday at 10 a.m. from St. Theresa's Catholic Church, in Eagle. The body will lie in state after 4 p.m. Sunday at the Mealy Funeral Home in Eagle. A rosary service will be at 8 p.m. Sunday.

Burial will be in St. Theresa's Cemetery.
