Marvin W. Bovee, 88, Eagle's oldest resident, died this morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Allan Howard, 1316 E. Broadway.

Bovee was born Jan. 31, 1859 in Eagle and spent his entire life there. His wife, the former Margaret Robinson, died four years ago.

A retired farmer, he was also president of the Mukwonago Town Mutual Fire Insurance Co., president of the Oak Ridge Cemetery association and a member of the Rob Morris Masonic Lodge of Eagle for the past 50 years.
