

KATHERINE BOVEE PARSONS

Katherine Bovee Parsons was born in Utica, New York, February 11th, A. D. 1840, and was a daughter of Philip V. and Charlotte Pitman Bovee. Came to Wisconsin with her parents when four years of age, and made her home here.

Was married Jan. 13, A. D. 1871, to Edward Button Parsons and engaged in farming south of the village. Retired some years ago and moved to the village where they bought a home and where she resided to the time of her death, April 3rd, 1925. Her husband preceded her in death.

The funeral took place from the M. E. church of which the family are members, April 8th, in the afternoon, Rev. W. J. Perry, pastor, officiating, and Mrs. Haywood, of Waukesha, sang Beautiful Isle and Christian Good Night, and interment was in the family vault in Oak Ridge cemetery.
