Death of Hon. David G. Snover.

The Eagle News gives a long and affectionate obituary notice of the Hoa.
David G. Snover, who died at Fort
Atkinson, July 18th. He was 62
years of age and had been in poor
health for some time, but the immediate cause of his death was a fall
from a step-ladder, upon which he was
standing to make some repairs about
his house. Funeral services were held
the 21st uit, from the family residence, and were attended by the impressive ceremonics of the Masonic
order.

Mr. Snover was a native of New Jersey: when a child he moved with his parents to Michigan, and at 18 years of age came to this county and settled in the town of Eagle, where he lived for many years. Later he resided in several Wisconsin towns, and finally in Fort Atkinson, where his death occurred. He was always prominent in public affairs, held a number of town officers in Eagle, and was elected to the state legislature in 1863. Both in private and in public he was much esteemed for his many admirable qualities of head and heart.
