On Thursday morning, July 1st, Samuel Bowey and his son, Fred, were hauling in hay on the farm north of Eagle, the load tipped over and Mr. Bowey fell to the ground on his head, sustaining injuries from which he died that evening. Mr. Bowey was born in Curry Mallat, Summersetshire, England, March A. D., 1852, came to America in 1873 and located at Genesee, where he was employed as herdsman by Mr. Meeham, which occupation he followed for nearly twenty years. He was employed by several of the leading Short Horn cattle breeders of that time. Was married in 1880 to Mary Engel of Whitewater and after farming in various sections of the state located at Eagle where he purchased the Richard Wilton farm, which he made his home.
