On Friday afternoon at the family home in Theresa, Wisconsin, occurred the death of Amelia Belling. Mrs. Belling was born in Lomira, Sept. 22, A. D. 1849, and was married to Carl Belling May 10, A. D. 1868. Her maiden name was Amelia Pade. The young couple engaged in farming and resided in the same neighborhood all of their life. Four children were born to them, Frank, now on the homestead, Mrs. August Schellpfeffer, deceased, August F., now engaged in business in La Crosse, and Arthur A., proprietor of the meat market at Eagle. Mr. Belling died Oct. 10, A. D. 1914, and after his death the mother resided with the son on the homestead. The funeral took place from the Lutheran church at Theresa on Monday afternoon and interment was in the church cemetery where lies buried her husband and daughter. Mrs. Belling made several visits to Eagle and has many friends here who extend their sympathy to the family in the loss sustained by the death of their beloved mother. Those from here who attended the funeral were Mr. and Mrs. Arthur A. Belling and daughter Mary, August F. Belling of La Crosse also attended the funeral.
