**Mother of R. J. Angell Dies
At Rosamond Home**

Following a serious illness, Mrs. Orilla Angell passed away May fourteenth, 1935, at Rosamond, California. Since the death of her husband, about three years ago, Mrs. Angell has made her home with her two sons, Ralph and Eugene Angell at Rosamond.

Mrs. Angell was born at Eagle, Wisconsin, March third, 1850, being one of nine children born to Mr. and Mrs. Ebenezer Thomas, who were pioneers in that section.

She was married, and made her home near Eagle, Wisconsin until about 25 years ago when the family moved to Fullerton, California, where she lived until her husband's death October twenty-first, 1932.

Surviving her are three sons, Ralph and Eugene of Rosamond, and Murray of Arlington, California, and one brother, Frank Thomas of Eagle, Wisconsin. She also leaves three grandchildren and one great-grandchild.
