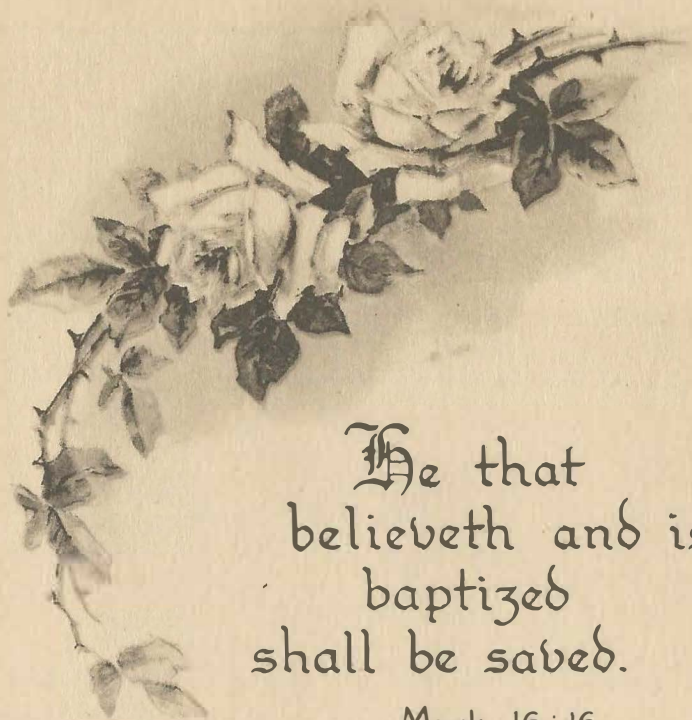

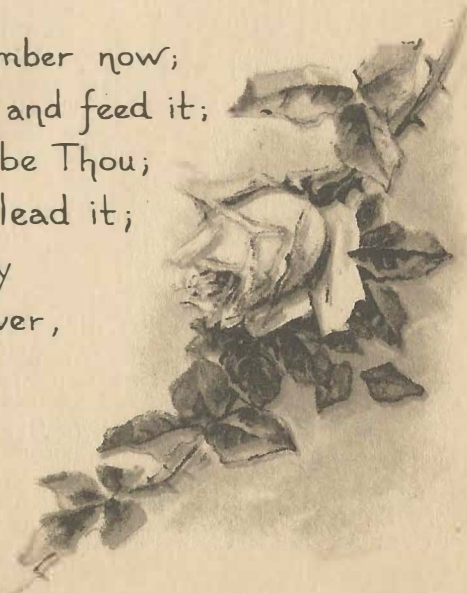



a child of God.

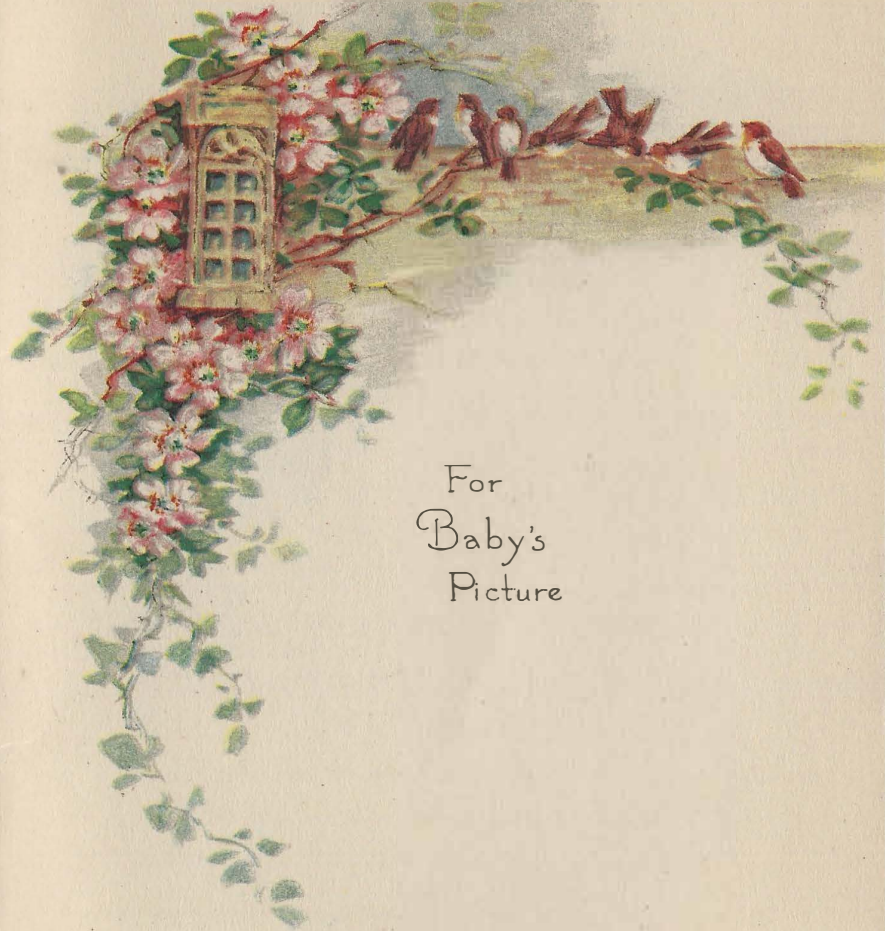

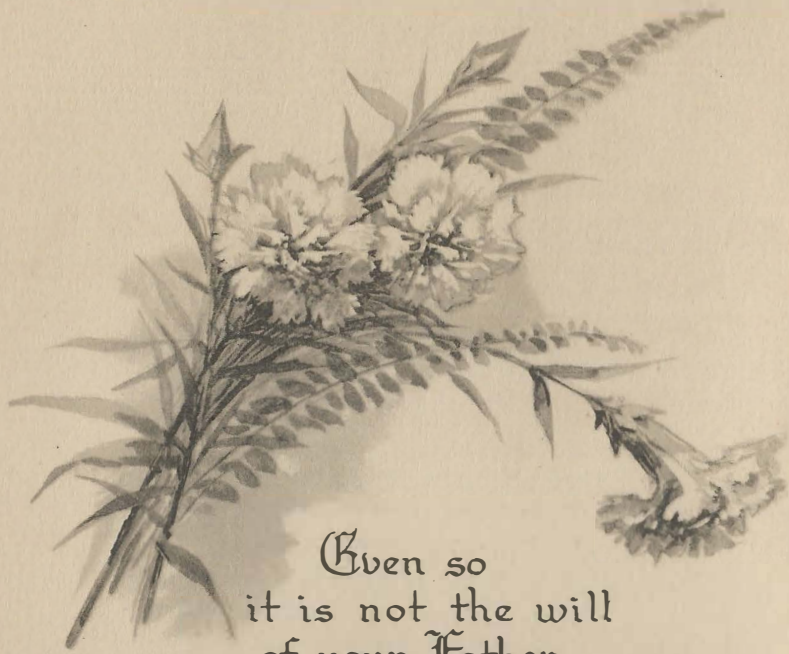
