Frederick Amann First Amann In Eagle

After the war, he settled in Eagle, where he lived for many years. Frederick Amann passed away on March 6, 1919, and is buried in Oak Ridge Cemetery in Eagle².

His family included his wife, Helen Long, who was born on April 22, 1851, and passed away on September 23, 1924¹. They had at least two sons, Joseph and Julius Amann
