

Clyde A. Aplin

PALMYRA — Funeral services will be held Tuesday at 2 p.m. for Clyde Andrew Aplin, 86, formerly of the Palmyra-Mukwonago area.

He died Saturday at the Sky View Nursing Home in Hurley, Wis., of complications of old age.

Aplin was born Aug. 28, 1887 in the Town of Ottawa, Waukesha County.
