

Steve Jolliffe

EAGLE TOWN — Steve J. Jolliffe, 85, former town assessor and long-time farmer, died Friday at Waukesha Memorial Hospital, where he had been for about the last 10 days.

Jolliffe of Rt. 2 was assessor for 18 years until retiring two years ago, and he farmed in the town until about 20 years ago.

"He did an excellent job for our community, and was a well-respected man," former town chairman Carl Seitz said. "I really feel that if anyone had any needs, he was there. He was the type of person who would give you the shirt off your back if you needed it. We are going to miss him."

Jolliffe also was a member of the Eagle School Board for 12 years, most of that time during the 1930s, and a member of the Eagle Methodist Church.

Survivors include wife Stella; daughters Mrs. Harvey Congdon of Hopkinsville, Ky. and Mrs. Arthur Kelms of North Prairie, son Robert of Eagle and sister Mrs. Bernie Riesen of Milwaukee.

The funeral will be at 8 p.m. Monday at the Mealy Funeral Home in Eagle, with burial in Little Prairie Cemetery near here.
