John Burden Accidentally Killed.

On Friday evening about 6.20 P. M. John T. Burden was accidentally killed while on his way home from the village. Mr. Burden, who resided south of here near the Elkhorn railway and this time returned just at the time the afternoon train was due to return. Some way or another Mr. Burden got on the railway and was struck by the train and killed. The coroner's jury rendered a verdict of accidental death. Mr. Burden was born in England 64 years ago and was a son of Mr. and Mrs. John (Mathers) Burden, came to Wisconsin with his parents when seven years of age. Was married to Harriet Wilton forty three years ago by whom he had six children, two of whom died. Those who survive him besides his widow are, Thomas H. Burden, Ward D. Burden, Mrs. F. A. Betts, Mrs. Chas. E. Cruver. The funeral occurred Monday forenoon, interment in Jerico cemetery. Rev. Crown of North Prairie officiated. Mr. Burden was one of Eagle's industrious citizens, was honest in his dealings with all and his accidental death is mourned by all. We all extend our sympathy.
