

Eagle Student Takes Own Life

EAGLE — Robert G. Bowey, a Mukwonago High school sophomore, shot and killed himself yesterday, apparently because he was despondent over a girl.

The 15 year old shot himself in the chest with a .22 calibre rifle in the bedroom of his home. He was pronounced dead shortly after 3:30 p.m.

BOWEY'S mother said Robert came home from school at 1 p.m. and told her he was ill. When she offered to call a doctor, her son said it wouldn't be necessary.

BOWEY WAS a good student his parents said, and had not been in poor spirits as far as they knew.

The youth lived at Eagle Rt. 1. In addition to his parents, he is survived by two brothers, Terence and Scott; grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Richard Williams and Mr. and Mrs. Fred Bowey and great - grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Belling. All are of Eagle.

FUNERAL services will be at 2 p.m. Friday at the Mealy Funeral home. The Rev. Robert Kuhn, pastor of Eagle Methodist church, will officiate. Burial will be in Oak Ridge cemetery.

Friends may call at the funeral home after 3 p.m. tomorrow. The family has requested memorials to the Eagle Methodist church in lieu of flowers.
