Eagle man dies of heart disease after clearing snow from roof

Village of Eagle - A 69-year-old man who collapsed in his home after climbing on its roof, and clearing snow from it, died of a heart problem later in the day at Waukesha Memorial Hospital.

Police provided the following additional information:

The man, Donald Chapman, 327 Eagle St., was taken by ambulance to the facility at about 11 a.m. on Jan. 7.

Chapman's 75-year-old sister had been visiting him, and called emergency personnel after his collapse. She initially thought he had fallen from the roof.

However, Police Chief Hans Lux, Jr., said "there was no evidence at the scene" of such a fall.

Emergency personnel performed cardiopulmonary resuscitation on Chapman before he arrived at the hospital.

He died of arterial sclerotic cardiovascular disease, according to the Waukesha County Medical Examiner's Office.

His sister is a Town of Genesee resident.
