FRANK CRANK DEAD.

Frank Crank died Monday, following an operation, at a hospital in Wausau, Wis. The deceased was born in Eagle and was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Anton Crank, pioneer settlers from Germany. His parents died when he was a small boy and he was taken to the Milwaukee orphan asylum for care and education. Later he spent several years on farms at Eagle. He was married to Miss Flora Harris and resided at Waukesha for a time and then removed to Wood county and engaged in farming. The funeral was held from St. Theresa's church Wednesday morning and interment was in Oak Ridge cemetery. He leaves surviving him the eldest brother, Frederick, residing in Chippewa county; two sisters, Mrs. Theresa James, Waukesha, and Mrs. John H. Maaga, Oshkosh.
