

Muskego, at Hys. 59 and 83 near Genesee Depot. Knack was not hurt. The car in which Cavey rode was driven by David A. Rockteacher, 17, Eagle, who is in satisfactory condition kesha Memorial hospital. The district is studying the possibility of filing at Wauattorney charges.

Eagle Youth Killed In County Accident

A 16 year old Eagle boy was killed in a two car crash on Hy. 59 at Hy. 83 one mile south of Genesee Depot Thursday night.

Dead is John Cavey, 16, of Waukesha st., Eagle, He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Cavey.

Young Cavey was a passenger in a car driven by David A. Rockteacher, 17, of 113 N. Eagle st., Eagle.

The Rockteacher car collided with one driven by Erwin Knack, 41, of Mukwonago Rt. 1, box 381A. Knack was uninjured.

According to sheriff's reports, Knack was attempting a left turn from Hy. 59 onto Hy. 83 at the time of the collision.

Dist. Atty. Roger Murphy said an investigation has been ordered to determine if charges will be filed against Knack.

Murphy agreed with Coroner James Welch that no inquest was needed.

Davey died of a skull fracture about 15 minutes after arriving at Waukesha Memorial hospital, Coroner Welch said.

Rockteacher was reported in satisfactory condition today suffering from deep cuts.

A third passenger in the auto, cemetery.

Steve Sadenwasser, of Main st., Eagle, was reported in fair condition with a broken jaw and cuts.

The right fronts of the cars collided, Both cars were damaged beyond repair. The accident occurred at 6:19 p.m.

The riders in the Rockteacher auto were headed to a volleyball game at Catholic Memorial high school in Waukesha when the accident took place.

The fatality raised the county toll to 45, the same figure as was reported on this date a year ago. The state toll today stood at 932 compared to 982 a year ago.

Survivors are his parents Mr. and Mrs. John Cavey of Eagle, brothers Justin and Michael and a sister Sr. Mary Roncali, Sisters of the Sorrowful Mother, Milwaukee.

John was a junior at Catholic Memorial high school.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a. m. Monday at St. Therese's Catholic church, Eagle. Friends may call at Mealy's Funeral home in Eagle after 2 p.m. Sunday. A rosary will be recited at 3:30 p.m. Sunday.
