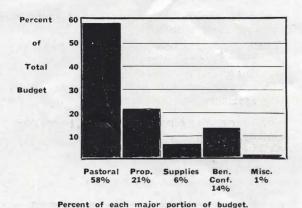

Let's see what these figures look like in some GRAPHS.

This graph shows how big a percentage of the total budget goes for each of the major sections of the budget.



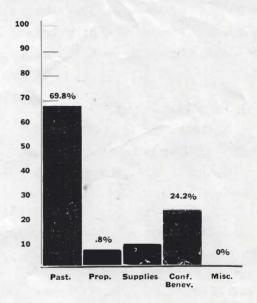
You can see that most of it goes for pastoral expenses and for our property expenses.

This graph compares the budget for next year with our budget for this year.



This is an increase of \$617.00. Figured in percentages it is an increase of 13.5% over last year's budget.

JUST WHERE IS THIS INCREASE GOING?



PRACTICALLY ALL OF IT IS ACCOUNTED FOR BY INCREASED PASTORAL EXPENSES AND INCREASED CONFERENCE AND BENEVOLENCE EXPENSES.

HOW ARE WE TO MEET THIS BUDGET?

This information is being sent to 151 families most of whom live in Eagle Township. If each one of these families, not individuals but families, contributed just 68c per week to the church our budget would be met! This is only \$2.95 per month! (If each one of these families was able to tithe, think of the work the church could do!)

1 family = \$ 0.68 per week + 150 families = 102.68 per week \times 52 weeks = 5339.36 per year.

OR

1 family = \$ 2.95 per month + 150 families = 445.45 per month \times 52 weeks = 5345.40 per year.

Some of these families, some of you who read this, will not be able to give even this. This means that some of the rest of use will have to contribute more. This is fair. God judges us not by the amount we give, but by what we can afford to give.

This isn't a heavy burden. Our budget will not be a heavy burden, if each one of us does his part. And if each one of us does his part, God's work shall prosper here in Eagle, and our lives will be blessed.
