

# Day of Prayer Set

The Kettle Moraine council of church women will hold its world day of prayer services at the Eagle Methodist church Friday 1:30 and 7:30 p.m.

These services have been held over the world for the past 82 years on the first Friday of Lent. The theme of this year's observance, in which Christians in more than 145 countries will take part, is: "Bear One Another's Burdens."
