PURPOSE

The meeting was called to elect new Committee officers and to get suggestions on how the Memorial Fund money should be used.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

John Boettcher was elected as Chairperson for the next year and Shirley Nelson was elected as Secretary.

MEMORIAL FUNDS

Actual dollar amounts in the fund were not available at the time of the meeting. *\$2390.64 - 250. Sign 444-drapes - 1000 for a living memorial*

- A. Mel Kugel suggested a LIGHTED SIGN for outside the church as a living memorial. It was suggested that if and when a sign was purchased, consideration be given to having unbreakable glass in the door to avoid vandalism. Discussion included the wiring for the sign and the fact that there is a possibility that the old wiring could still be used.
- B. Dexter Badinger feels there is a great need for a new DRAPE BEHIND THE CROSS. He also is concerned about having a new drape cover the complete arch rather than just the insert behind it as the wood needs refinishing badly and it would be very costly to have it restored. Mel Kugel said that he would get an estimate on the drape some time this month. The question was also asked as to the need for new curtains behind the altar to match the one behind the cross. It was decided that this could be discussed further after getting the estimate for the drape. It was the general feeling that if a new drape is purchased, the color should match the carpet as near as possible.

OTHER CONCERNS

John Boettcher asked for input for getting the inside of the Church windows puttied and painted. It was suggested that it could be done during the summer months when school is not in session and asking some of the students that belong to the church and aren't holding summer jobs to help. John volunteered to supervise the activity and feels it would possibly make the younger people feel more a part of the church.
