

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

I, VINTON J. SHERMAN, a resident of Eagle, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, being of sound mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all former Wills and Codicils heretofore by me made.

ARTICLE I

I hereby direct that all of my just debts, the expenses of my last sickness, funeral expenses and the expenses of the administration be paid out of the principal of my estate.

ARTICLE II

All of the rest residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal or mixed, whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated, I give, devise and bequeath as follows:

A. I give \$500.00 to each of the following: RUTH ANN ROLF, DON JONES, MRS. DEAN JONES, HARVEY WAMBOLD, MRS. ROYAL HOUK, MRS. C. G. BAYER, provided they shall survive me. If any of them predecease me, then this legacy shall lapse.

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B. The remainder of my estate is to be divided as follows:
6% to St. Theresa's Catholic Church of Eagle, Wisconsin, 6% to the
Methodist Church of Eagle, Wisconsin, and the remainder is to be divided
equally among the following: MRS. FRANCIS KRAMER of Eagle, Wisconsin,
MRS. BERNICE CLOHISY of Arlington, Virginia, MRS. MARY LOU HINKLEY of
Wauwatosa, Wisconsin, MR. VINCENT P. CLOHISY of Long Island, New York,
MRS. MARY FRANCIS BERG of Springfield, Missouri, MR. JOHN E. CLOHISY of
Chicago, Illinois, MR. THOMAS M. CLOHISY of Fairfax Station, Virginia,
MRS PATRICIA ROULEAU of Fairfax, Virginia.

If any of these persons shall predecease me, his share shall go
to those persons who would have been his heirs-at-law if he had died at
the date of my death. I further direct that before the property shall be
divided in the percentages given above, the above recipients shall have
the right to divide all personal and household articles owned by me at
the time of my death among themselves as they see fit. This shall apply
only to personal items owned by me not having any substitutive market
value.

ARTICLE III

I hereby nominate and appoint FRANCES KRAMER as Personal
Representative of this my Last Will and Testament. If she shall
predecease me, or for any reason decline or be unable to act in such
capacity, I hereby nominate and appoint MARY LOU HINKLEY and THOMAS
MATTHEW CLOHISY to act as Personal Representatives jointly, with equal
powers, of this my Last Will and Testament. It is my will and I hereby
direct that my Personal Representative herein named, or the alternate

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Personal Representatives hereby named shall not be required to furnish bond while acting in such capacity. It is my Will and I hereby further direct that my Personal Representative or the alternates, as the case may be, shall have the authority to sell, mortgage or dispose of any of my real estate, real, personal or mixed, without first obtaining the authority therefore from any Court.

ARTICLE IV

Further, I direct that my Personal Representatives retain the law firm of COOK & HICKEY, Waukesha, Wisconsin, to act as attorneys for my estate, because of their familiarity with my financial situation.

ARTICLE V

In this Will the use of the masculine gender shall be deemed to include the feminine and vice versa and the use of the singular or plural case shall be deemed to include the other where appropriate.

ARTICLE VI

It is my Will and my intent and I direct that any person not specifically named within this Will is to be excluded from my will.


