# Chamber music series features flutist, pianist

## Former Eagle resident making return to area

EAGLE – The Kettle Moraine Chamber Music Series has announced its inaugural concert for this season.

Flutist Sarah Miles and pianist Marie Blair will perform at 7 p.m. Oct. 29 at the Eagle

Methodist Church, 305 E. Main St., Eagle. The concert will feature the works of Arthur Foote, Aaron Copland, Katherine Hoover, George Gershwin and Robert Muczynski.

Miles is a former resident of Eagle and a graduate of Palmyra-Eagle High School.

She is completing a doctoral degree in musical arts from Michigan State University and holds a master's in music and a bachelor's degree in music from Louisiana State University.

Miles made her solo debut at the age of 18 with the Monroe, La., Symphony as a winner of that orchestra's young artist competition.

She toured the Eastern U.S. with the American Wind Symphony Orchestra, has performed with

As a pianist, Blair has performed concerts in Michigan, Ohio, Nebraska, Florida, New York, Manchester and London, England and Bermuda.

She has performed concertos with the Michigan State University Wind Symphony, the American Wind Symphony Orchestra and the Royal Northern College of Music Baroque Ensemble.
