STATE OF WISCONSIN.—WAUKESHA COUNTY.—In County Court.

In the matter of the estate of Fremont A. Betts, deceased.

Letters of administration on the estate of Fremont A. Betts, late of the town of Eagle in said county of Waukesha, deceased, having been granted to Luella M. Betts by this Court, on the 14th day of July, 1911:

It is ordered, That the time from the date herof until and including the first day of February, A. D. 1912, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time within which all creditors of said Fremont A. Betts, deceased, shall present their claims for examination and allowance.

It is further ordered, That all claims and demands of all persons against the said Fremont A. Betts, deceased will be examined and adjusted before this Court, at the Court House, in the city of Waukesha, in said county, at a regular term thereof appointed to be held on the first Tuesday of February, A. D. 1912, and all creditors are hereby notified thereof.

It is further ordered, That notice of the time and place at which said claims and demands will be examined and adjusted as aforesaid, and of the time above limited for said creditors to present their claims and demands, be given by publishing a copy of this order and notice, for four consecutive weeks, once in each week in the Eagle Quill, a weekly newspaper, published in the village of Eagle, in said county, the first publication to be within fifteen days from the date hereof. j21-a11.
