

## S. E. Duller

Sarah Elizabeth Arnold was born on March 2, 1842, in Johnston, Rhode Island. She married Alfred Alexander Duller on January 14, 1858, in North Providence, Rhode Island. He was fifteen years older than Sarah. Shortly after their marriage, they moved to Illinois where they had two daughters, then moved to Wisconsin in 1862 where they had an additional 11 children.

Alfred was a plasterer by trade and was commissioned to work on the Wisconsin State Capitol building where he was the foreman of the operation, later becoming a contractor. The family lived many years in Stoughton, Wisconsin, and later settled in Janesville, Wisconsin where he died in 1898. Alfred is buried in Janesville.

Sarah remained a widow the rest of her life. She died in 1932 in Janesville, Wisconsin, at the age of 90, and is buried at Milton Lawns Memorial Park in Janesville.

## Harriet (Hattie) Duller

Harriet S. Duller was born on July 9, 1870, in Madison, Wisconsin. Her father, Alfred, was 46, and her mother, Sarah, was 28.

She married Henry C. Showers in 1890. He was twelve years older than her. She was a dressmaker and they had two children during their marriage.

Henry Showers was a "Saloon Keeper" in Stoughton, Wisconsin. Henry died in March 1903 and Harriet remarried Jacob Strommen, a Stoughton house painter/interior decorator, in Aug 1903. She died on January 22, 1942, in Dane, Wisconsin, at the age of 71, and is buried at Riverside Cemetery in Stoughton, Wisconsin.
