

ASKS \$10,000 DAMAGES.

Frank Falter Brings Suit Against Edward Burton of Eagle for Alleged Alienation of Wife's Affections.

WAUKESHA, Wis., Oct. 9. — [Special.]—Frank Falter has brought suit in the county court against Edward Burton, a resident of the town of Eagle, for \$10,000 damages for the alleged alienation of his wife's affections.

The Falters were married in Chicago in 1901, when she was but 15 years old. Falter became acquainted with his wife through a matrimonial advertisement in a paper. The complaint alleges that in June, 1905, the plaintiff and his wife went to live in a house owned by the defendant. Falter was at that time employed at Eagle lake and absent from home much of the time. He alleges that on August 1, 1905, and at divers times thereafter the defendant called on his wife, finally alienating her affections from him. Burton is at present the defendant in a criminal case, brought against him by Falter, which is pending in the municipal court, having been continued over the term at the September term of court.
