## Harold J. Pardee

Harold J. Pardee, of Eagle, died yesterday at Wisconsin General hospital. He was 72.

Pardee was born in Eagle, March 29, 1877, and was the grandson of Eagle's first settler, A. R. Hinkley. In 1925 he was married to Aurel Baker. He farmed near Eagle all his life and was active in all civic and church enterprises there. He sold his farm three years ago and retired.

He is survived by his wife, Aurel; a niece, Mrs. Gilbert Thomas of Waukesha, four sisters-in-law and several cousins.

Funeral services will be held Monday at 2 p.m. from the Methodist church at Eagle. The Rev. J. Tomlinson will officiate and burial will be at Little Prairie cemetery.

At the time of his death Pardee was a member of the village board and president of the Oak Ridge cemetery.
