


# Good screen fun



Nintendo Wii bowling is gaining popularity among senior citizens, who are getting a chance to learn about the video game system at area libraries.

## Seniors hop on Wii bandwagon

**M**abel Finney wasn't intimidated by teenage boys, even if they were far more savvy in video gaming.

Showing up at her local public library to join an all-ages Nintendo Wii bowling tournament, Finney, 81, gave it her best shot.

"Some of us were better than the young ones," she said. "It was just so much fun. It's a barrel of fun."

Finney, of Eagle, is one of a growing number of seniors taking

advantage of interactive Wii gaming events popping up at local libraries.

While hospitals, rehabilitation centers and nursing homes have snapped up the game systems for their therapeutic benefits, public libraries are adding the consoles for fun and exercise.

The Waukesha County Federated Library System used grant funds this year to buy Nintendo Wii and Sony PlayStation 2 video gaming equipment with the intent to use them to entice teenagers, especially boys, to libraries. But librarians around the county are seizing the opportunity to also

offer them to older generations.

Adult Wii bowling open houses and tournaments have been added in recent weeks to libraries in Brookfield, Sussex and Eagle. Sussex held its first adult Wii event Sept. 10. In August, Brookfield started a monthly Wii league for "seasoned bowlers."

### More to come

Mukwonago wants to add more adult gaming events after offering one night of "Wii for the rest of us."

"The way I phrased it was if you remember when PacMan came out the first time — which was

1972 — then you were invited," said Jacquie Hipsman, reference librarian at the Mukwonago Community Library.

One grandmother who attended that event enjoyed it so much that she later told Hipsman she bought a Wii system for her home. She uses it, and when her grandchildren visit, they play together.

The Salem Community Library in Kenosha County is holding its first "grandparent/grandchild" Wii bowling tournament Oct. 4.

Brookfield's library also bought one Wii console this year and uses


