Thadeus Earle married Dorothy Shaw in 1774 and lived in Templeton, Massachusetts. Their children

Thadeus died in 1779, his wife married a man named Mower and after his death moved to Westford in 1803

Alpheus lived in Westford, dismissed to Williston in 1825 and was drowned in the Onion Liver in 1836

Calvin lived in Westford, , moved to Illinois after 1828. They had nine children.
