

Dr. John Earl Baker To Speak on China

Dr. John Earl Baker, advisor to the Chinese government and inspector-general of the Burma Road, will address a public meeting at 3:30 p.m. tomorrow in the student YWCA cottage, on "Taking China Off the Famine Map." The East Bay Committee of the China Christian Colleges, of which Mrs. Warren Olney, Jr., is chairman, is sponsoring the meeting. Chinese music will be furnished by the girls of the Ming Quong Home.

Dr. Baker is director of the Red Cross in China, supervised the work among 286,000 refugees in Shanghai, and has traveled extensively throughout the country.
