The Bovee bodies were moved to Oak Ridge after Dewitt Bovee, a grandson of Matthias J Bovee, was buried there in 1908. Scott Bovee, g-g-g grandson of Matthias J Bovee tells the story that when the Bovee family saw the graves of the old cemetery laying in an old overgrown field they felt it was almost sacrilegious to leave their loved ones there so they moved them to Oak Ridge Cemetery in 1907.

Jane (Dodds) Bovee, mother of Matthias Bovee, was buried on the old Bovee farm, now the Sprague Farm.
