

Mrs. Robert G. Shearer

Mrs. Robert G. Shearer, whose death was reported in last issue, was born Sept. 10th, 1905, at Cashton. She was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Conrad Vonrueden, Sr., of Cashton, Wisconsin. She attended common school and graduated from the high school in the class of 1924, attended Wisconsin State Business College in LaCrosse and then went to Milwaukee where she was employed until her marriage to Robert G.
