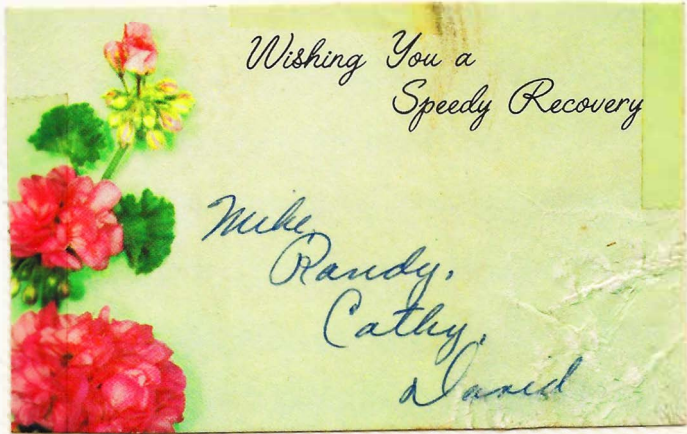


# Recovering After Tractor Accident
