

Asaph Perry  
1849-1936

Mr. Asaph Perry, one of our older residents, passed away at his home Friday evening following a period of ill health extending over the last two years. Mr. Perry was born at Troy Center, Wis., Sept. 8, 1849, and was married in 1869 to Mary Ann Fairbrother, who preceded him in death. In 1871 Mr. and Mrs. Perry journeyed to Nebraska, making the trip in a covered wagon, where they remained for 14 years. They returned to Wisconsin in 1885 where they engaged in farming until 1915.

Rev. William Petherick officiated at the funeral Monday afternoon, which was held in the M. E. church. Burial was in Oak Ridge cemetery. Surviving are nine children: Mrs. William Murdock, Mrs. J. M. Rockteacher, Charles Perry and Mrs. A. A. Belling, of Eagle; Mrs. G. M. Henrichsen of Minnesota; Mrs. J. E. Dunning of Chicago; Guy Perry, Frank Perry and Mrs. Robert Green of Mukwonago.
