BURTON TO FILL VACANCY ON COUNTY BOARD

Donald T. Burton, rte. 1, Eagle, was named from seven candidates to fill the 35th District seat on the County Board of Supervisors. The vacancy was caused by the death of Byron Hardaker, and includes the villages and towns of Eagle and Mukwonago.

Burton is a member of a pioneer Eagle family. He graduated from Waukesha high school and received his Bachelor of Education degree from Whitewater State University, and his Masters Degree from Northwestern. For 25 years he taught in the Racine school district, living there while teaching, but also managed the operation of his 250 acre Eagle dairy farm. In 1958 he retired from teaching and devoted his time to farming, and raising Guernsey cattle.

He holds several state and local dairy farming posts, including treasurer of the Wisconsin Guernsey Association, and a member of the Farmers Home Administration Committee. He also heads the Palmyra School Board.

County Judge Harold Wolenzien administered the oath of office to Mr. Burton.
