

First Generation.

Samuel Hinckley, the immigrant and wife Sarah came to New England in A. D. 1635 in the Hercules. Settled at Barnstable on Cape Cod in the then Plymouth Colony. Wife Sarah who was the mother of all his children died in Barnstable Aug. 18, 1656. He married a second, the widow Bridget Bodfish. Mr. Hinckley died in that part of Barnstable called Great Marshes Oct. 1662. He had 11 children.

Second Generation.

John Hinckley, son of preceding § in Barnstable May 24, 1644. Baptised the second day following his birth by Rev. John Lothrop and died in Barnstable Great Marshes Dec. 7, 1709 aged 65 years. He was twice married. His first wife who was the mother of all his children was Bethia, daughter of Thomas and Sarah (Ewer) Lothrop and grand daughter of Rev. John. They were married in July 1668. She died in Barnstable July 10, 1697. aged 48 years. having been born in Barnstable July 23 1649. He married second Nov. 24, 1697. Mrs. Mary Goodspeed widow of Benjamin Goodspeed and daughter of John and Hannah (Linwell) Davis. John H. was known by his contemporaries as Ensign John. H. holding that position in the military an honorable one in his day. He was a farmer and large land holder. He had a family of eleven children. Four of his five sons settled in Connecticut. Towit--Samuel and Jonathan in Stonington, Ichabod in Yolland (?) and Gershan in Lebanon.

Third Generation.

Samuel Hinckley, son of the foregoing born in Barnstable Feb. 2, 1670-1 and died in Stonington, Conn. Aug. 16, 1751 in his 82nd yr. He was married in Boston. I have the date but cant seem to put my hand on it to Martha Lothrop. I have found date of marriage Sept. 19, 1699. Penn Townsend Esq. She was daughter of John and Mary (Cole) Lothrop of Barnstable born there Nov. 11, 1677 and died in Stonington. May 22, 1703 Samuel Hinckley and his cousin Henry Cabot (or Cobt) then both of Barnstable, bought a tract of land jointly of Benj. Palmer (?) in Stonington which tract was improved in company until May 5, 1722 when a division was made. The part assigned to Samuel Hinckley has continued in the possession of the family to the present time.

of Deacon Gershan Palmer and wife Ann Denison. This Ann Denison was the daughter of Captain George Denison and wife Lady Ann Bordel. This Ann Barodel was the daughter of John Barodel of Cork, Ireland who were Protestant Irish. Captain George Denison was the son of William and Margaret Denison of Roxbury Mass. who came to this country with the apostle Elliot in 1631. Deacon Gershan Palmer was the son of Walter and Rebecca Palmer. Walter Palmer came to this country in 1638. Deacon John Breed (?) removed from Lynn, Mass. to Stonington in 1689. He was the grandson of Allen and wife Elizabeth Breed (?) who were the immigrant ancestors of the Breed(?) family of New England reaching Boston soon after 1630. I have not the date of decease of either John Hinckley or his wife Elizabeth. They both died in Stonington. I will qualify this statement a little. John Hinckley died when quite young in Stonington. His widow married as a second William Walworth son of William and Mary (Seaton) Walworth and had by him two or more children. Gershan Hinckley Johns son born Sept. 4, 1730. married Cath erine Wightman and removed to Pittston (?) Rensselaer Co. N.Y. in 1768 and from there to Rome N.Y. Descendants of his were among the first settlers of Van Buren Co. Michigan. Many of them including the Dykeman family are living in South Haven Mich.
