To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS *Orramel Hinckley, of Milwaukee County, Wisconsin Territory,*

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at *Milwaukee* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Orramel Hinckley,*

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for *the South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section ten, in Township five, North, of Range seventeen, East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Milwaukee, Wisconsin Territory, containing forty acres,*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Orramel Hinckley,*

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said *Orramel Hinckley,*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Orramel Hinckley,* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *James K Polk* **PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** have caused these Letters to be made **PATENT**, and the **SEAL** of the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.
