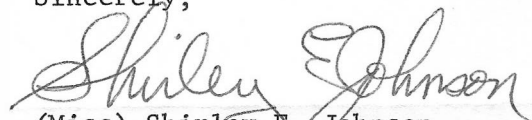
Dear Miss Potter,
