Subject Establishment of public library

Narrative: Alice Baker, an elderly resident of Eagle, is concerned about the lack of public library service in Eagle and had corresponded with us earlier in the summer. At that time I promised to call on her.

Miss Baker had thought that funds could be raised in sufficient amount to provide a trust fund for the operation of a library. Prior to my coming I had sent her information on systems and apprised her of the work of the Waukesha County Library Committee.

As a result of our visit, she thought it wiser to wait for the committee's plan and instead of promoting fund raising for a library to promote the need for service in the community and so advise the committee.
