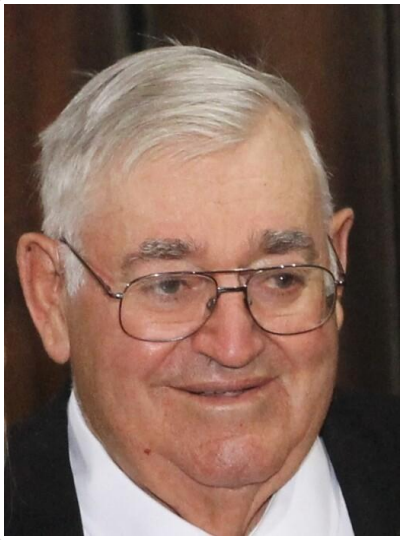


Robert C. Loefer
